## Police officer new york salary

By Ashley Donohoe Updated August 10, 2020 While firefighters help rescue people when fires and accidents occur, police officers are working to stop crimes, catch those who cause them and keep the general public safe. These careers usually don't require a college degree, but they do have important training that you'll need to complete. A firefighter's salary in the U.S. tends to run lower than that of a police officer, though these public safety careers have similar job prospects. A police officer's typical day can include handling traffic problems, arresting people, monitoring premises, checking vehicles for illegal items and assisting with non-emergency situations, such as blocking vehicles. Their work requires reporting, obtaining warrants when necessary, interviewing witnesses, issuing referrals and warrants and driving to various locations as they get called all day. They also receive evidence that investigators and courts can use to prosecute criminals. Firefighters have a narrower role in leading mainly to areas such as traffic accidents and building fires to help extinguish fires and help those trapped or injured. While they have medical training, they will often have an ambulance come along so that paramedics can provide additional medical support in emergencies. The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics says they also spend enough time training and maintaining their equipment. BLS says police officers should have the physical ability to do the job, complete a police academy program and be 21 years of age or older. Firefighters usually start by obtaining EMT certification before completing additional months of training through a fire department or academy. They can join the fire department at the age of 18 versus 21 for police officers. Columbia Southern University further states that a criminal history can exclude you from these public safety jobs. Both careers require extensive practical training and real-life simulations. Once at work, they usually go through a period of work under close supervision until they demonstrate high proficiency. Working as a police officer or firefighter involves handling stressful situations safely and dealing with physical hazards during the workday. These careers require working in any kind of weather conditions, getting overtime as needed and dealing with unpleasant situations. They are also physically demanding roles. For example, firefighters work 10- to 24-hour shifts, where you may need to take off in a tent at any time, and must wear heavy gear to protect themselves at work. Police officers often work overtime and see intense situations. BLS may 2019 salary figures showed an average police officer's salary of \$67,600, with most salaries ranging from \$36,960 to \$105,230. BLS data lists a lower average firefighter salary of \$54,650 in the US with most making between \$25,550 and \$90,020. Most police officers and firefighters worked for local governments, where the corresponding average salaries of \$67,480 and \$55,780. When considering the firefighter's salary from the state, California and New Jersey offered higher corresponding average salaries of \$84,370 and \$80,890. The salaries of police officers from state data listed California and Alaska as the states with the highest corresponding average salaries of \$105,220 and \$87,870. Use of 2,031 self-reported police salaries in August 2020, PayScale reported that police officers earned an average of \$44,349 with less than a year of experience, \$48,383 with one to four years, \$52,409 with five to nine years, \$60,783 with 10 to 19 years and \$73,880 with 20 years or more experience. The 1,459 salaries firefighter PayScale collected showed a lower average salary of \$40,972 with less than a year of experience, \$41,698 with one to four years, \$48,104 with five to nine years, \$56,477 with 10 to 19 years and \$70,631 with 20 years or more. BLS expects the same 5 per cent employment growth rate for police and firefighters between 2018 and 2028, and this is the same as the average rate the office expects for all occupations. Local crime rates can affect demand for police, while budgets can lead to changes in both police and firefighters' jobs. The use of volunteer firefighters can affect paid jobs in this role. Having advanced education such as a college degree with some relevant experience can help you find any of these jobs. BLS says turnover will add some police positions, but competition should remain high. Firefighters can benefit from medical training for better prospects. Some go to law enforcement to help maintain a peaceful, law-abiding environment. Each person has different reasons for choosing their specific career paths. The majority of police officers aim to help others and ensure that the law is followed for the safety of all citizens. Some people also choose different positions within law enforcement. For example, a police detective can apply for this position in order to discover facts. Police detectives are often very detailed and spend their time searching out in the field. To fulfill their sworn duties to protect the public from harm, police officers enforce the laws to protect life and property. They patrol areas in their jurisdiction, arrest crime suspects and write reports. They earn their wages through a typical 40-hour week, and sometimes receive paid overtime. Because police protection is required 24 hours a day, officers' schedules can include evenings, nights, weekends and public holidays. Police officers averaged \$56,260 a year, or \$27.05 an hour, as of May 2011, the Bureau of Labor Statistics says. But their wages could be as high as \$84,980 a year, or \$40.85 an hour, or as low as \$32,080 a year, or \$15.42 an hour. The best average wages were with state governments at \$60,650 a year, or \$29.16 an hour. It also provided the second largest number of jobs with 10 per cent of jobs. Employers are looking for applicants who have at least one high school diploma, though some agencies, such as the federal government, require a degree. After retirement, officers who meet certain qualifications, such as being over 55 and have at least 10 years of service, receive subsidies for medical insurance based on years of service and if the retiree is reached 65, the age to cover Medicare. As of 2012, for those retiring after July 2011 the maximum monthly subsidy was \$1,097 for those without Medicare, or for those who were 65 and enrolled in Medicare Part B.
