I believe you're the victim of a military romance scam while the person you're talking to is a foreign national posing as an American soldier who claims to be stationed overseas on a peacekeeping mission. It's the key to the scam they always claim to be on a peacekeeping mission. Part of their scam is saying they don't have access to their money because their mission is very dangerous. If your friend girlfriend/husband-to-be/wife asks you to do the following or exhibited this behavior, it's probably a scam:Going to a private messaging site immediately after meeting with you on Facebook or SnapChat or Instagram or some dating or Locate media. They often delete the site you met immediately after asking you to go to a more private messaging siteProfesses love you very quickly - seem to quote songs and song words along with using their own broken language, as they declare their love and dedication quickly. They also showed concern for your health and your love for your family. Promise marriage as soon as they get to the country.For vacation they asked you to pay for it they ask for money (wire transfers) and Amazon, iTune, Verizon, etc. gift cards, medicine, religious practices, and leaves to come home, internet access, full work assignments, help a sick friend, get him out of trouble, or anything that sounds suspicious. The military provides all the soldier's needs, including medical treatment for food and transportation for vacation. Trust me, I lived it, you'll probably be tricked. I'm just trying to show you examples that probably deceive you. Below is an e-mail response I received after I sent an investigation to the U.S. government when I found out I had been tricked. I got this wonderful response back with a lot of useful links on how to find and report your crook. And how to learn more about romance scams.Now you can also copy the image he gave you and done a Google image search and you hope to see the pictures of the real person he's posing in. It doesn't always work and take some digging. If you find the real person you can direct a message to them and alert them that their image is being used for fraud. Good luck to you and I'm sorry this could happen to you. Please continue reading the government response I received below that is very informative. You contacted an electronics doel being fired by the U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command. Unfortunately, it's a common concern. We assure you there's never any reason to send money to anyone who claims to be a soldier on the Internet. If you've only spoken to this person online, they're probably not an American soldier at all. If this is a suspicious social media profile masquerading as possible, we urge you to report it to this platform as soon as possible. Soldiers are not charged money for secure communications or leave. Soldiers don't need permission to get married. - Soldiers emails are in this format: john.doe.mil@mail.mil < caution-mailto: john.doe.mil@mail.mil > Anything that ends .us or .com is not an official email account. - Soldiers have medical insurance, which pays for their medical costs when treated in civilian health facilities around the world – family and friends do not have to pay their medical expenses. Used to transport privately owned vehicles. - Military financial offices are not used to help soldiers buy or sell items of any kind. - Soldiers deployed in combat zones do not have to ask the public for money to feed or to house themselves or their soldiers. - Deployed soldiers can't find large unsalted sums of money and need your help to get that money from the state. Anyone who tells you one of the above conditions listed/correct circumstances will likely be posing as a soldier and trying to steal money from you. We urge you to immediately cease all contact with this person. That way, you can quickly go through most forms and eject them to say - an SQL database, which includes a link to the original image of the form you filled out. If you see black boxes in three corners of the document - it's likely set up for scanning (they help identify and direct the page digitally). If there is a unique barcode on the document somewhere I would appreciate there is an even higher likelihood of it being scanned - the document is valuable enough to be printed separately which costs more, which means it is probably going to be used on the capture side. (I've noticed in the past in the Bahamas and other Caribbean islands that they use these kinds of capture mechanisms, but they have far fewer people coming in than the U.S. does every day) the real answer is: it depends. In accordance with each country and its policies and regulations. Normally I'd be surprised if they scanned and held on paper. In the U.S., they most likely file these for a set period of time and then destroy them, possibly mining them for some data on travelers. In I suspect the likelihood of capturing paper for the data of customs forms moves somewhere on such a spectrum: the Third World Customs guy has paper to show he did his job, paper thrown at the end of the shift. ----->We're saving all the documents! Everything is scanned as you pass by customs and unique barcodes to identify which flight/gate/area the form shares, so we coordinate with cameras at the airport and captured your image.
